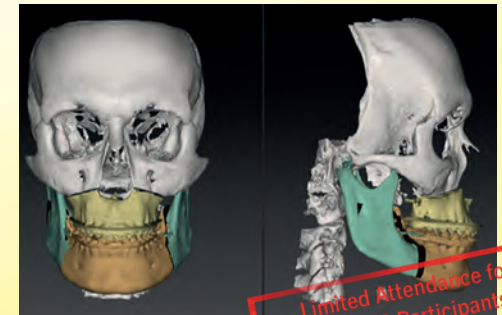

International S.O.R.G. Course

Purpose

Many maxillofacial trainees have good experience of operative orthognathic surgery, but lack confidence in treatment planning – a crucial aspect of orthognathic care. Orthognathic planning involves both orthodontist and surgeon, and it is vital that both have not only a thorough understanding of the principles and practice in their own discipline, but also that of their orthodontic or surgical partner in the team. This course aims to give participants a firm basis for clinical orthognathic treatment planning, covering both orthodontic and surgical aspects, through lectures, hands on case planning, and lively discussion.

Target Audience

Trainees in oral and maxillofacial surgery and orthodontics, who wish to understand the principles and practice of orthognathic planning.

- 1) To understand selection criteria for orthognathic surgery
